No. I was fortunate enough to be taught the do's and don't's of prison life shortly after arriving here.

How have you resolved these difficulties or dealt with them?

I dealt with them by learning my lessons well and recognizing my mistakes when they were pointed out to me. Also, by being patient and observant.

How has a life of incarceration changed you?

I have come to respect others and their opinions. I have come to understand better the consequences of my actions and that what I do don't only affect me but others as well.

Have you remained in continual contact with family or friends since becoming incarcerated?

Yes.

If you were granted a second chance and released, what would you do?

My plans are to get settled back into society, work with my uncle in the heating/cooling business he has, and involve myself with the troubled youth.

My goals are to continue to learn while I am here. I have always used my time by reading. Then there is exercise, more reading, then writing and even more reading.

While in prison, I've been involved in one fight early on during my time. Two dangerous contraband tickets (both ten years or older), numerous out of place tickets, a few possession of stolen property, failure to disburse, a few substance abuse/alcohol tickets. I was in a level 5 for 4 years at the highest and level 2 at the lowest.
