Have you remained in continual contact with family or friends since becoming incarcerated?

I cannot say I've been in continual contact with family and friends

because not too long ago I did not hear anything from anyone for about 2 years. But I am very grateful to God to have the family and friends I have now! God is Good!

What would you do if granted a second chance and released?

If I am granted a second chance and released, I WILL GIVE THANKS TO GOD and those who have assisted in helping me get out! I will walk and lead in the way to show my son how to become an honest, caring, God-fearing man, at the same time giving my younger siblings something better to look up to!

I have completed my G.E.D. programming, vocational training (Custodial Maintenance), and numerous substance abuse courses/classes. I would love to further my education, but they do not allow free college courses here any longer!
